Bristol Virginia Sheriff's Office

The Bristol Virginia Sheriff's served the citizens of Bristol Virginia in the following capacities in 2010: maintaining the safety and security of the jail, operations at the courthouse, serving civil process, providing D.A.R.E. to our school age children, operation of the jail farm, crime prevention programs and property abatement/right-of-way clean-up. In 2010, the Sheriff's Office had fifty-one full time staff, (this included administrative, dieticians and medical personnel) and four part-time deputies.

Jail

The jail had 47,758 inmate days reported, with an average inmate daily population of 131.

In 2010, cattle and hogs were raised for meat products for the jail. Hay was grown/cut for feed for the livestock. The labor for the farm was accomplished with inmates, providing savings and vocational skills for those assigned.
