HOW TO MAKE A COMMENDATION

- 1. If you wish to commend the actions of a deputy or about any aspect of our operations, please:
 - a. Come to the office and tell any appointee that you want to make a commendation, or;
 - b. Call the office and tell the person answering the phone that you want to make a commendation; or,
 - c. Write your commendation and mail it to the sheriff; or,
 - d. Print out <u>REPORT A COMMENDATION</u> form and return by any mail or fax to the Sheriff.
- 2. If needed a supervisory deputy will assist you in filling out a commendation form. This form asks you to identify yourself and then to give specific details about your commendation.
- 3. Your commendation will then be reviewed. You may be contacted and asked additional questions about your commendation.
- 4. When your commendation has been reviewed, the sheriff will forward the commendation to the deputy(s) involved.
