HOW TO MAKE A COMPLAINT

- 1. If you wish to make a complaint about any aspect of our operations, to include sexual assault of an inmate, please:
 - a. Come to the office and tell any appointee that you want to make a complaint, or;
 - b. Call the office and tell the person answering the phone that you want to make a complaint; or,
 - c. Write your complaint and mail it to the sheriff; or,
 - d. Print out REPORT A COMPLAINT form and return by any mail or fax to the Sheriff.
 - e. Complaints may be filed anonymously or filed on behalf of a third party.
- 2. If needed a supervisory deputy will assist you in filling out a complaint form. This form asks you to identify yourself and then to give specific details about your complaint.
- 3. Your complaint will then be investigated. You may be contacted and asked additional questions about your complaint.
- 4. If it is going to take a long time to investigate your complaint, you will receive a letter telling you approximately when you may expect a reply.
- 5. When your complaint has been investigated, the sheriff will review the investigation and will write you a letter explaining what has been found out about the matter.
